

Cathy Kurth Dance Academy 2025-2026

Below is a list of all expenses you will incur while at CKDA. Please read all information carefully. If you have any questions or concerns, please email us at LexiCKDA@gmail.com.

There is a **\$50 non-refundable Registration Fee** (+ \$10 for each additional child) due at registration.

Parents enrolling in “autopay” through the parent portal will have fees incurred for this transaction waived.

{There is a **\$10 Late Fee** added to all tuition that is 30 days past due}

Tuition is the same each month whether the class meets two, three or even five times. Tuition is charged based on the following scale and is **due the first of each month.**

Monthly rates are as follows: 1/2 hour class is \$35, 3/4 hr class is \$45, 1st full hour of instruction is \$50, 2nd hour adds \$35, and 3rd hour or more adds \$25 per hour. ****Additional children receive 25% off**

Classes will begin **Monday, September 8, 2025**. We follow the same calendar as the Calcasieu Parish Schools for Fall Break, Thanksgiving, Christmas, Mardi Gras and Easter. We will not have afternoon classes on Halloween. We **do not** take off any other school holidays or teacher in-service days. The only holidays we are closed for are: Fall Break (Oct 13-Oct 14), afternoon of Halloween Oct 31, Thanksgiving (Nov 24-28), Christmas (Dec 22-Jan 5), Mardi Gras (Feb 16-Feb 18), Easter/Spring Break (April 03-April 10).

Costumes are required for our annual dance recital. The costume prices are as follows:

*****Costumes must be paid in 4 equal installments that will be added to tuition September – December. Costumes must be paid in full by December 1, 2025 for us to order your child’s costumes. Please note that costume fees already include tax.** The state requires us to charge sales tax on costumes.

There is a **\$50 Recital Fee** (+ \$10 for additional children) due with April’s tuition.

All fees and tuition are non-refundable. Should your child wish to drop a class, notify the studio **AS SOON AS POSSIBLE**. If we are not notified that your child is dropping before tuition is posted you are responsible for that month. Costumes are custom ordered and cannot be returned. Once costumes are ordered, you are responsible for them. There is a \$10 late fee on accounts more than 30 days past due. There is a \$25 NSF fee charged on all returned checks.

Our 39th annual recital and MANDATORY dress rehearsal will be June 13, 2026 & June 14, 2026 at the Rosa Hart Civic Center. Stage rehearsals that we strongly encourage everyone to attend will be June 11, 2026 & June 12, 2026. Please do your best to have your child at ALL June rehearsals, whether at the Civic Center or studio. We will have a Kinder Performance (PreK / Kinder, 1st-2nd

grade classes & Acro 2) **as well as a Gala Performance** (3rd grade classes and up/ Acro 3 & up). ***PreK Acro, and Level 1 Acro Classes do not perform in the recital.***

From September - March dancers with excessive absences may be asked to take private lessons in order to continue in their classes. Beginning in April dancers missing more than three classes in the same class (April - June) will be taken out of formations and missing 3 consecutive classes in the same class will result in dancer not being allowed to participate in the show. Attendance is extremely important as we near recital - there is partner work, formations and lifts that cannot happen without all of the dancers in attendance.

We are not responsible for classes cancelled due to “acts of God” such as flooding, dangerous icy conditions, illnesses, extreme weather etc.

Auto Pay – You can enroll for auto pay easily through your parent portal. We will draft your payment between the 1st and 5th of the month. ONLY TUITION will be drafted. All costume fees, recital fees, registration fees, etc must be taken care of independently by you- either online through your parent portal or in the office. **We WILL NOT auto draft costume fees or recital fees.**

Cathy Kurth Dance Academy 2025-2026 “What Do I Need?”

All dancers are required to wear a black leotard to all classes. Bikers are allowed in acrobatics classes. Bikers or jazz pants are allowed in jazz and tap classes. Ballet students need pink tights. No skirts, pants or shorts in ballet classes. ****Any black leotard and /or anything purchased in our shop is allowed in dance class as long as it meets the above-mentioned qualifications.****

Dancers need a **dance bag** for their belongings. **Please put your child’s name in all belongings**, including leotards, shoes, bags, etc. We are not responsible for items left at the studio, lost or stolen. ****Please exercise caution when allowing your child to bring jewelry or electronic devices (phones, ipods, etc).**

****Please note that the color shoe needed for recital may change once costumes are picked****

- **PreK:**
 - Jazz/Tap/Acro class: They will need pink ballet shoes, black tap shoes (NO ties – ONLY elastic or Velcro), and a dance bag. They will need a black leotard and pink tights. Black skirt or shorts are optional. Put their names on all of their belongings!!
- **Kinder:**
 - Tap/Ballet/Jazz class: They will need pink ballet shoes, black tap shoes (NO ties – ONLY elastic or Velcro), and a dance bag. They will wear their pink ballet shoes for jazz as well as ballet. They will need a black leotard and pink tights. Black skirt or shorts are optional. Put their names on all of their belongings!!
 - Acro: Black leotard with shorts. No shoes.
 - Musical Theater: Black leotard with shorts, skirt, or pants. Tan jazz shoes.
- **1st – 2nd Grade Classes:**
 - Jazz/Ballet/Tap classes: Black leotard and pink tights. Black skirt or shorts are optional for tap and jazz. They will need pink ballet shoes & tan tap shoes (NO ties – ONLY elastic or velcro). They will wear their ballet shoes for jazz.
 - Hip Hop: Black leotard and shorts and black jazz shoes.
 - Lyrical: Black leotard and shorts or a skirt and pink ballet shoes.
 - Musical Theater: Black leotard and shorts or a skirt with tan jazz shoes.

- Technique: Black leotard and shorts or a skirt with pink ballet shoes or jazz shoes.
- Acro: Black leotard with shorts. No shoes.
- **3rd – 5th Grade & Up:**
 - **Acrobatics**: Black leotard and biker shorts. No loose clothing or jewelry. No shoes or socks are needed.
 - **3rd – 5th Grade Tap**: Tan "mary jane" tap shoes. **No ties allowed!**
 - **JH & HS Tap**: Black laced tap oxford.
 - **Jazz 3rd Grade & Up**: Black leotard with biker or shorts or jazz pants. Black or tan jazz oxfords - ***Color of jazz shoes needed for recital will ultimately depend on costume.
 - **Musical Theater** – Black leotard with shorts, skirt or pants. Tan Jazz shoes.
 - **Hip Hop**: Black leotard and pants or shorts. Black Jazz oxfords or black sneakers that are only used for dance class (to protect our floors).
 - **Lyrical & Contemporary**: Black leotard and shorts or skirt. Half soles or bare feet (check with teacher)
 - **Ballet**: Black leotard and pink tights only. Pink ballet shoes with pink elastic sewn across instep.
 - **Pointe**: Black leotard and pink tights only. Pink pointe shoes. Students must be 11 years of age or older and have teacher's permission to take pointe.
 - **Technique/Versatility/Pilates/Turns**: Black leotard and biker shorts. For shoes students can go barefoot or wear half soles, jazz, or ballet shoes.
 - **Pom**: Students will need tan jazz shoes. There will be a \$30 pom fee due by September 1st. This will cover the cost of the poms they will use for practice throughout the year. These poms will also be used for recital. If your child loses their poms it will be your responsibility to replace them.

Leotard/appropriate dancewear is mandatory for all dance/acro classes and may be worn only as denoted above. In order to ensure that your child get the most out of each class, please see that he/she comes to class properly prepared and dressed appropriately.

Hair: Please keep hair out of child's face. Hair should be secured away from face and worn in such a way as not to impede your child or others. For acro, it is recommended that hair not be worn directly on top of the head, as this tends to hinder the child during rolls, headstands, etc.

Attendance: Attendance is of the utmost importance for *any* participant in *any* activity. Children missing excessively fall behind quickly and become frustrated and disheartened. Excessive absences are unfair to your child and the other children in the class. ***Children missing and falling behind as recital nears may not be allowed to participate in the recital*** without receiving private lessons. Private lessons range in cost from \$50 to \$75 per hour and are the sole responsibility of the parent. ***We reserve the right to move your child to a lower level class if poor attendance is causing her/him to fall behind.*** If your child has 3 or more absences for the same class from April 1st - June 14th, they will not be able to perform that number in the recital without private lessons from their teacher. If your child misses 3 times consecutively during this time they will be removed from the number. It is of the utmost importance that your child attends classes in the months prior to recital.

Perfect Attendance: Trophies are awarded to students who have "perfect" attendance at the end of the year. To receive this award students ***must not miss any classes*** and must be enrolled for at least 6 of the 9 1/2 months of classes.

Contact Information: Please be certain that your contact information (address, **email** and all phone numbers) is always kept current. We will communicate with you via email, and must have correct contact

info in order to ensure that you receive all pertinent information. **It is your responsibility to keep informed.** Please make sure that you have at least one emergency contact listed on your account.

Snacks and drinks are allowed only in our waiting area. No gum is allowed at the studio at all. Always be respectful of other dancers, our facility, our teachers and staff

IMPORTANT CLASS INFO FOR 2025-2026

PreK/Kinder Classes: Our preschool and Kindergarten classes are both hour long classes and are combo classes. PreK will do tap/ballet/acro during class time and will perform tap & ballet dances in the recital. Kinder will do tap/ballet/jazz during class but will perform one dance in the recital as specified on the schedule. Each class will have one costume fee. Children in kindergarten also have the option of enrolling in our Acro 1 classes.

1-2 Jazz/Ballet/Tap Classes: Our 1st-2nd grade Jazz/Ballet/Tap classes are combined and will only do one dance in the recital, this also means there will only be one costume fee for this class. They will still be learning the skills and technique needed for all styles of dance. We feel that by only working one dance to perfect for the recital, this will allow us to work on more of the skills that are needed in both ballet and jazz.

Pointe Classes: Only dancers with teacher permission may enroll in pointe. To begin pointe class you must be at least 11 years old. You must also take ballet in addition to pointe. Pointe will have its own costume fee. You cannot only take pointe. Please check with your child's ballet teacher if you would like to enroll in pointe classes.

***Acrobatic Classes:**

Level 1 Beginner - cannot do standup backbend (no costume – no recital performance)

Level 2 Can do standup backbend unassisted and strong cartwheel

Level 3 Can do standup backbend, strong cartwheel, properly execute front limber and backbend kickover

Level 4 Can do all of level 3 requirements plus properly execute back and front walkovers

Level 5-6 Can properly execute standing back handspring, running side aerial, and round off with at least a single back handspring.
